



Setting a Benchmark in Mining Industry:

TMC's revival of the JOY package established a new industry standard for reusing legacy mining equipment. By achieving what seemed impossible, TMC demonstrated the potential for transforming outdated assets into productive solutions, showcasing its innovative approach to complex challenges.





Global Search and Procurement Excellence:

TMC's procurement team was instrumental in reviving the JOY Continuous Miner package by sourcing rare components globally. Their efforts, paired with the engineers' ingenuity, reinforced TMC's leadership in advanced mining technology.

In 2002, South Eastern Coalfields Limited (SECL) introduced India to a groundbreaking shift in underground mining by deploying its first Continuous Miner (CM) package from JOY Global at the Anjan Hill mine. This advanced technology, comprising the Continuous Miner, Shuttle Car and Feeder Breaker, revolutionized coal production. Over the next 18 years, these machines traversed SECL's mines, producing more than six million tons of coal. However, by 2020, wear and age rendered the equipment non-operational, reducing it to mere scrap.

The story took a turn in 2022 when TMC decided to redeploy this outdated package at the Jhilimili mine. Despite the daunting condition of the machines and the unavailability of spares from original manufacturers, TMC rose to the occasion. Embracing the challenge, TMC's engineers launched an ambitious global search for solutions, traveling across the globe. Their mission: to source rare components, re-engineer vital systems, and restore these once-dormant machines to operational glory.

Months of painstaking effort and innovative problem-solving followed. TMC's team worked tirelessly to revive and overhaul the machines, blending expertise with an unwavering commitment to excellence. Their determination paid off as the aged CM package, once resigned to the scrapyard, was transformed into a fully functional, productive asset ready to meet the demands of underground mining. This remarkable achievement not only demonstrated TMC's technical expertise but also underscored its ability to overcome seemingly insurmountable challenges, setting a new standard for innovation and resilience in India's mining industry.
