An agreement was executed between **Sarda Energy & Minerals Limited** and **TMC Mineral Resources Private Limited** on **December 24, 2024**, regarding the Mine Development of **Sahapur West Underground Coal Mine** for Package I (Driveage of Inclines and few other activities), located at Sohagpur Coalfield, District **Shahdol, Madhya Pradesh**. The mine shall be operated using advanced mechanized technology, with the deployment of a **Continuous Miner capable of producing 0.6 MTPA** of coal from underground using **high-mechanized methods**.
